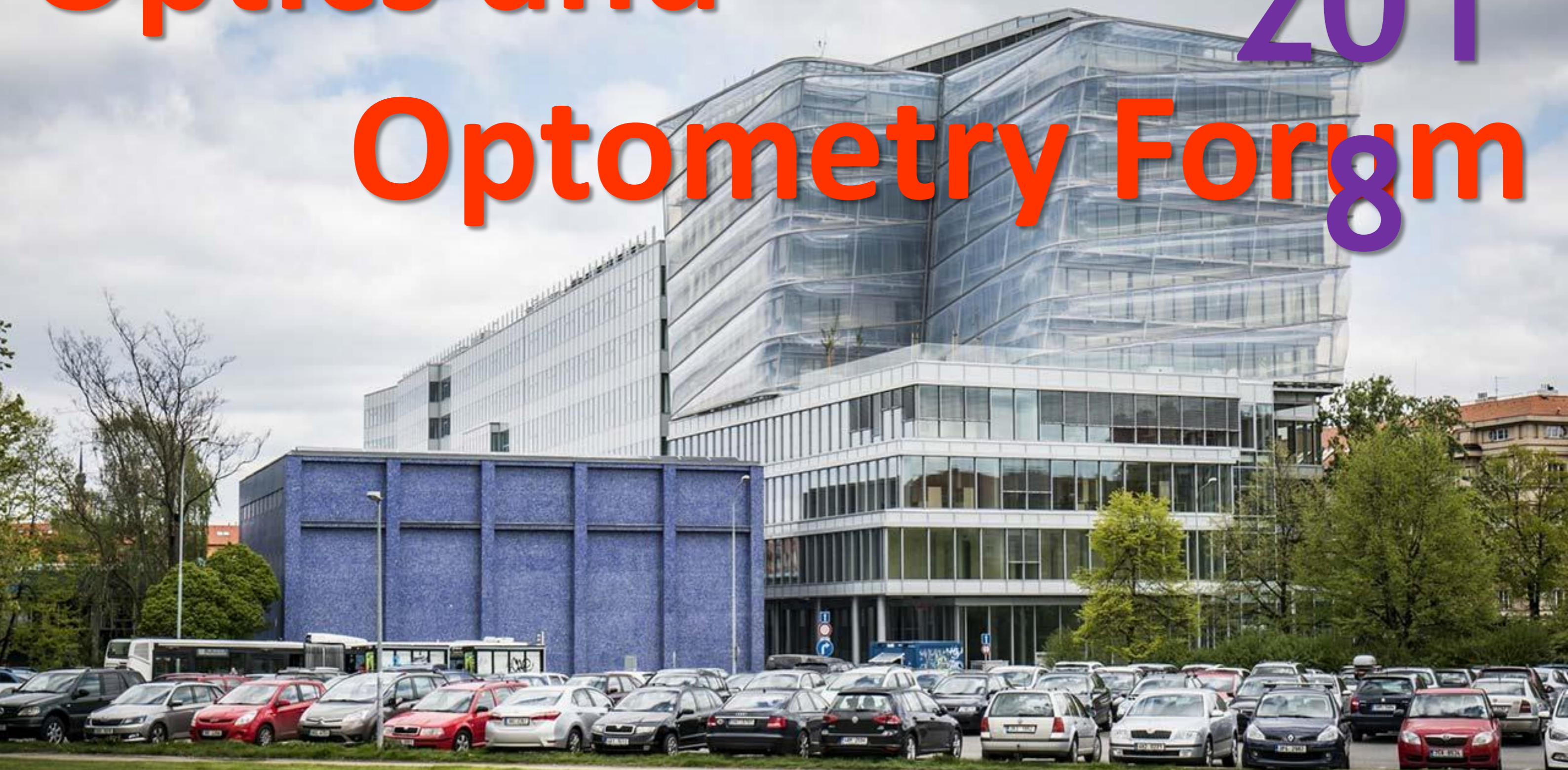

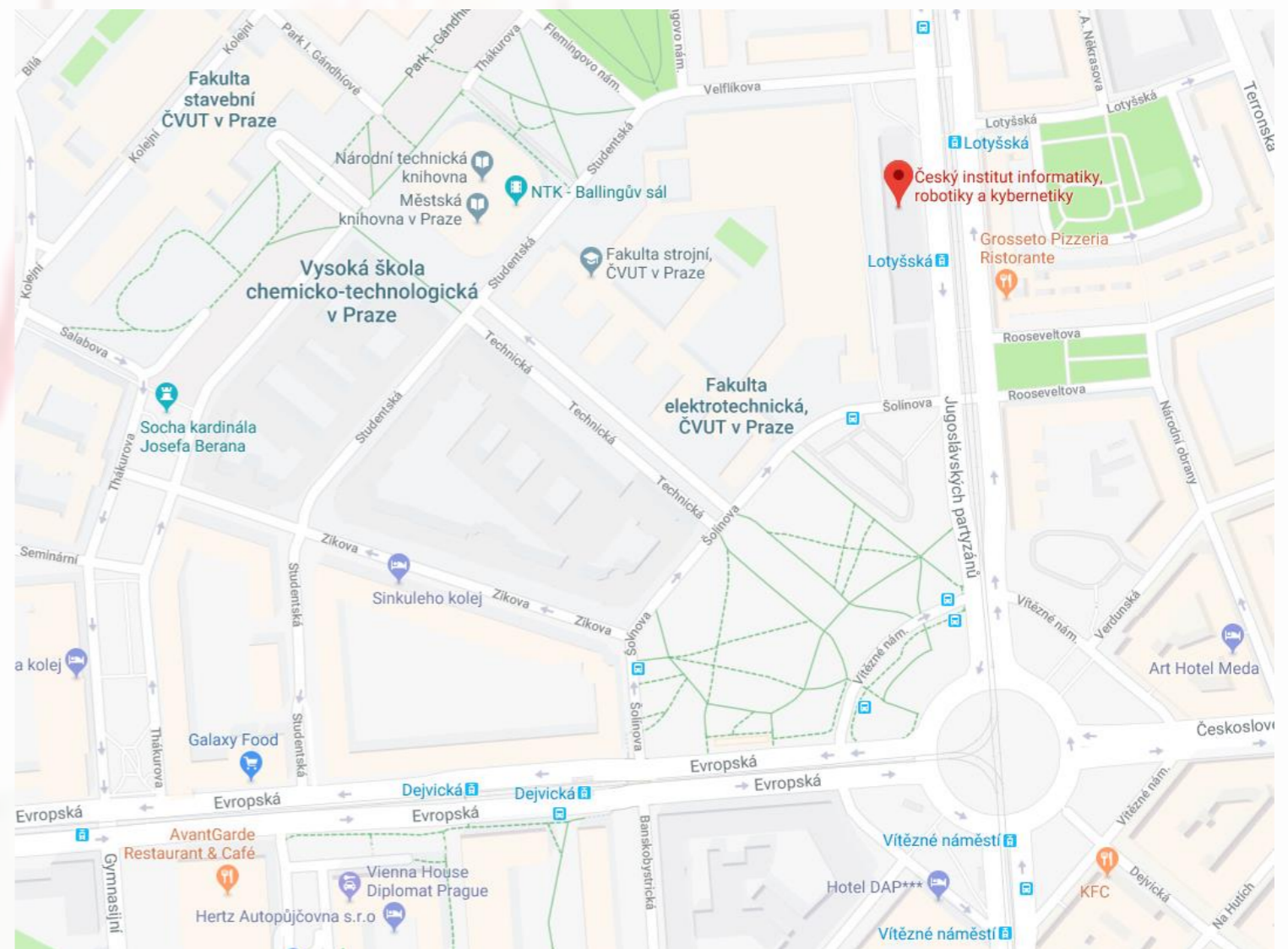


Conference venue, accommodation

Students' conference Optics and Optometry Forum 2018 takes place in a new building of the **Czech Institute of Informatics, Robotics and Cybernetics (CIIRC)** at the address:

Lectures will be held in Red Hall (room 246). Poster presentations will be located in the foyer. The place is reached easily by the metro or tram (400 m from metro station Dejvická – green line A, 50 m from tram station Lotyšská). The parking area or garages are also near the building.
